## **Notes Accompanying Adventure Angling Society application form**

## Please read these notes carefully before completing the application form

- 1. You must use a separate application form for each applicant
- 2. Cheques should be made payable to 'Adventure Angling Society'. Permits will not be issued until the check has cleared. Applications which are accompanied by cash will be processed as quickly as practicable. Please do not send cash by post. The permits will be issued as early as practicable prior to the start of the season. Please get your application in as soon as possible to avoid delay and disappointment.
- 3. Please include a stamped addressed envelope so we may return your permit promptly.
- 4. Your permit will be invalid if it does not contain a reasonably current passport sized photograph of yourself, permanently affixed to the permit in the place indicated along with your signature.
- 5. Juniors (under the age of 15) must be accompanied by a senior member of Adventure Angling Association or a non-fishing parent.
  Juniors aged between 15 and 17 may fish unaccompanied so long as the secretary has received a brief written request specifically requesting this privilege from a parent or guardian.
  If you are over the age of 17 years on 16<sup>th</sup> June in the year that you are applying for
  - If you are over the age of 17 years on  $16^{th}$  June in the year that you are applying for an application, you are deemed to be a senior member.
- 6. It is important that you include your telephone number and email address on the application form. Newsletters and other important information can be simply communicated without the club suffering costs. Savings on communications costs can then be invested into the lake.
  - Your details will never be shared with third parties.
